- 3. Grievances may be filed between 9:00 A.M. on Monday, December 26, 2022 until 9:00 A.M. on Thursday, December 29, 2022. No further grievances will be considered after that time.
- 4. Grievances received over email, support tickets on the website or phone calls will not be considered.
- 5. Process of raising grievances:
 - a. Login to your CLAT account;
 - b. Click the 'Submit Grievance' button;
 - c. State the nature of your grievance;
 - d. Describe your grievance (max. 1,000 characters);
 - e. Upload supporting documents;
 - f. Submit the declaration form;
 - g. Click the 'Submit' button.
