

GUIDELINES & PROCESS FOR LPUNEST-2017

1. INTRODUCTION

Lovely Professional University is conducting National Entrance and Scholarship Test (LPUNEST-2017) for all the programmes of the University except Diploma in Plant Protection and Pesticide Management and B.Sc. (Physician Assistant). This test serves dual purpose of eligibility and scholarship.

The following table explains for which programmes LPUNEST-2017 is considered an eligibility/ entrance test and for which programmes it is scholarship test.

3) HOW TO APPLY

3.1 Application form

Application form for LPUNEST-2017 (Diploma, Under Graduate-CAS; UG Lateral Entry; PG Sciences; PG Arts, Education & Commerce; M.Tech.; MCA; LL.M. Programmes), is available in Part C of Prospectus 2017, and is also known as Pre-Application Supplement (PS).

Application Fee for Admission is ₹ 900. Application fee once paid will not be refunded.

3.2 Application forms can be obtained and submitted using one of the following methods

A. Option-I After Purchasing Prospectus 2017

Applicant may obtain Prospectus -2017 from University Campus / Camp Offices or any other prescribed place by paying cash or providing Demand Draft drawn in favour of "Lovely Professional University" payable at Jalandhar.

Once the applicant has obtained the Prospectus 2017, form can be submitted by one of the following methods:

Manual Application:

- a. Fill the full application form after reading all the instructions as specified in "Instructions for filling Application Form".
- b. The filled application form, specifying "Application for LPUNEST-2017" and "Programme Applied for (Diploma, Under Graduate-CAS; UG Lateral Entry; PG Sciences; PG Arts, Education & Commerce; M.Tech.; MCA; LL.M. Programmes),," on the backside of the sealed envelope, be submitted
 - In person, either at the Admission Office at the university campus, Phagwara (Punjab) or at the designated camp offices of the university or at such other places as specified by the university;

Or

- By Registered Post/ Courier in good quality envelope to :

Note: Applicants are hence advised to ensure that the application is duly filled and dispatched along with complete enclosures in all respects.

Semi- Online Application - In case applicant does not want to send the hard copy of purchased application form:

- a. Fill the application form at www.lpu.in
- b. When prompted for payment, choose the option "Prospectus Code" (That can be obtained on scratching the top right corner of the title page of PART C of Prospectus 2017).
- c. Submit the complete online application form along with the Prospectus Code.
- d. Submit and save the copy of completed application form for your reference.

B. Option-II Without Purchasing Prospectus 2017

Applicant can apply for LPUNEST-2017 without purchasing Prospectus 2017 by filling the admission form online:

Online Application: Apply through the University Website (Internet banking facility required).

- a. Fill the application form at www.lpu.in
- b. Pay ₹ 900/- through online payment when prompted.

Note: For on-line application, Applicant should have Internet Banking facility through Net banking / Debit card / Credit card / Paytm wallet

Printout of the computer generated application should be retained by the applicant for reference.

All our correspondence including slot booking and issuing of e-hall ticket/ appointment letter/ admit card details will be through email only. Therefore, the applicants are requested to get ready with valid email id and mobile number for contact. No separate communication will be done for the same.

3.3 Incomplete Applications

Incomplete application will not be processed. LPU will not take responsibility to inform these applicants. Such applicants will not be able to access the Online Slot Management System.

Note: Applicants are hence advised to ensure that the application is duly filled.

4. ONLINE SLOT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

After submitting the application to the university, applicants need to use Online Slot Management System for the following activities:

- To book Test Slot
- To download E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card

- To check the allocated slot by the university. (If applicant has opted that university will book the slot).

4.1 Username and Password

Username and password can be obtained in the following ways:

Option I: If applicant has purchased a hard copy of the Prospectus 2017 (even if submitting it online after purchasing it):

- Username of the applicant will be application form number.
- Password/Prospectus code for accessing the test website is given on title page of Part C of Prospectus 2017.

Option II: If applicant is applying online

Username of the applicant will be his/ her e-mail ID. Password will be self generated by the applicant. The online form will be completed after the payment of ₹ 900.

IMP: If the Application form is being submitted at the University Campus, the processing time will be 48 working hours. But for Application submitted in Camp office of the University, the processing time will be at least 4 working days.

4.2 Username and Password Instructions

- This user name and password must be remembered to check the updates related to the test.
- The security of your password is totally your responsibility. The university will not be held accountable or responsible for any claim or loss that results directly or indirectly from any unauthorized use or misuse of your password.
- The Password must be kept confidential. Do not disclose it with others or write these down or store them in a file on your computer or auto save passwords.
- Your password is required:
 - To book a schedule using "Online Slot Management System"
 - To download e-hall ticket/Appointment letter/Admit card from the website
 - To check the allocated slot by the university. (If applicant has opted that university will book the slot)
- Once University receives the Application Form, an e-mail regarding Username and Password will also be sent to the applicant. So, fill your valid e-mail ID in the application form.**

4.3 Online Test Booking System:

Applicant is required to fill the column in Application Form [Pre-Application Supplement (PS)] for LPUNEST-2017, whether he/she will book the slot for taking test himself/herself or he/she wants the university to book the slot for him/her.

Option-I Booking of the Slot by the Applicant

- Online Test booking system is a web based online scheduling system available at www.lpu.in.
- While booking your test schedule, please ensure that you have the following with you:
 - A photocopy of your submitted application form
 - User name and password
- Applicants can book the test schedule at any centre, date and time of their choice.
- The scheduled bookings are done on first-come-first-serve basis and are subject to availability.

Option-II Booking of the Slot by University

- Applicant has to specify 5 choices of exam dates on the Application Form [Pre-Application Supplement (PS)] only.
- University will allot any one date (preferably from the given choices) for the exam as per the availability of exam slots. University will process the request for exam slot within 48 hours after receiving the application form. However all application received before the start date of the slot booking will be processed only when Online Slot Management will be activated.
- Applicant has to visit www.lpu.in regularly and is required to fill username and password to check the allocated slot for the test.
- In case of non-availability of any of the slot out of the 5 choices filled by the applicant or due to any postal delay, the university may allocate any other date to the applicant.

4.4 Important Points for Online Test Booking Procedure

- A slot once booked cannot be changed. By default request for change in test centre, date or slot will not be entertained. However under exceptional circumstances the request for change in date or test centre for LPUNEST-2017 may be considered only after receiving an application on prescribed format along with the processing fee of ₹300 from the applicant. An interface is available on university website www.lpu.in for change of slot booking.
- In case of non-availability of slots in a centre of choice, the applicant may choose to book a slot in an alternate centre.
- If for any reason, including poor response of applicants for appearing at a particular centre, a test centre has to be cancelled, the applicants who had opted for that centre will be allotted another centre. LPU will inform such applicants individually through their registered e-mail ID and Mobile Number.
- The online test booking system is available only to those eligible applicants who have submitted the application forms complete in all respects on or before the last date as mentioned under the head "Schedule of the Tests" in Part B of the Prospectus 2017.

- e. It is the responsibility of the applicant to book his/her test schedule in Online Slot Management System in the given time frame if he/she has chosen to book the slot himself/herself. LPU will not be held accountable for the non-bookings. The fee for the Prospectus 2017 will not be refunded under any circumstances in such cases.
- f. A confirmation mail will be automatically sent to the registered email address after the applicant has booked his/her schedule through the online slot booking interface.

Important Note:

- I. In the rare and highly unlikely event of a technical failure during the test, the applicant may be required to attempt for the test again.
- II. Applicants must regularly visit www.lpu.in to obtain latest news, information and updates on LPUNEST-2017.

5. E-HALL TICKET/ APPOINTMENT LETTER/ ADMIT CARD

Process for downloading E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card:

1. **For Applicants who booked their test slot themselves:** The E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card will be generated immediately after the applicant has booked the schedule through the online test booking system.
2. **For the Applicants whose test slot is being booked by the University:** As already mentioned, test slot will be booked within 48 hours of receiving of the application form, so E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card will be accordingly made available at www.lpu.in.
3. Applicant should provide the application username and online test booking password to download the E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card. The copy of E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card will also be mailed to the applicant. Applicants must provide valid email ID in the application form.

The E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card will bear the e-hall ticket number, address of the test centre, test date and time allotted to the applicant. Discrepancies, if any, must be brought to our notice immediately at lpunest@lpu.co.in.

The E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card will NOT be dispatched to applicants via post or fax.

Applicants should ensure that a printer is connected to their computer while printing the E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card. Applicants should take two print outs of the E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card using the print option on A4 size paper only. Please ensure that all information on the E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card is clearly visible on the print out.

No applicant will be permitted to appear for the test without a valid E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card.

Applicants must not mutilate the E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card or change any entry made therein after it is authenticated and received by them. The E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card is not transferable to any other person. Impersonation is a legally punishable offence.

The E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card is an important document, it must be preserved and produced at the time of admission also.

Report to the selected test centre with two copies of the E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card, one photocopy of the application form and any one of the following for photo identification:

- Candidates younger than 18 y/o: School IDs acceptable.
- Candidates 18 and older: Can bring ID cards with photo only (Signature not mandatory)
- Other ID proofs allowed:
 - Permanent driving license
 - Passport
 - PAN Card
 - Government-issued ID containing photograph and signature

6. ONLINE ENTRANCE TEST

6.1 What is Online Entrance Test :

Online entrance test is a Computer based test. Its salient features are:

- a. The applicant sits in front of a computer. The questions are presented on the monitor and the applicant submits his/her answers through the use of mouse. The computer is connected to a server, which delivers the test, in real time through a reliable connectivity.
- b. Online entrance test assumes that the applicant has basic familiarity with use of computers like use of keyboard and mouse operation. It is the responsibility of the applicant to acquire these skills before appearing in the test. The University cannot take responsibility for the same.

6.2 Procedure for Online Entrance Test

- The applicants must ensure that the computer allotted to them is switched on. Any problem with the computer should be brought to the notice of invigilator immediately.
- The questions appearing on the screen will be in English. All questions will be of Multiple Choice with (MCQ type).

- Each MCQ will consist of a stem which may be in the form of a question or an incomplete statement and four responses labeled A, B, C and D. Out of four responses only one is correct or the most appropriate answer. Applicants must choose the correct or most appropriate answer by clicking on the button next to the answer. Applicants can navigate freely through the questions.

Rough Work

All rough work should be done in the paper/s supplied at the Test Centre. No paper(s) should be taken into the test hall for this purpose.

Negative Marking

There will be no negative marking for wrong answers or unattempted questions.

7. REGULATIONS AT THE TEST CENTRE

- Applicants should arrive at the test centre as per the reporting time mentioned in the e-hall ticket. There will be pre-test process which includes registration and an on-site orientation prior to the start of the actual test. If an applicant arrives after the on-site orientation has begun, he/she will not be allowed to take the test. The test hall will be opened 30 minutes before the commencement of the test.
- Applicants have to register their name at the registration counter. The e-hall tickets of the applicants will be checked to satisfy about the identity of each applicant. A photograph of the applicant will be clicked at the test centre for verification purpose.
- Each applicant is allotted a seat with a computer. Applicants must find out and occupy their allotted seats at least 15 minutes before the commencement of the test.
- Applicants will not be allowed to carry any textual material, printed or written, bits of papers or any other material except the e-hall ticket inside the test hall. Applicants are also not permitted to bring calculators, slide rules, electronic watches with facilities of calculators, laptop or palmtop computers, personal stereo systems, walkie-talkie sets, mobile phones, paging devices or any other object/device that is likely to be of unfair assistance.
- No applicant will be allowed to go outside the test hall till completion of the entire duration of the time. Once an applicant leaves the hall (even if only to answer the call of nature) they may not be allowed to return under any circumstances. Smoking in the test hall is strictly prohibited. Tea, coffee, cold drinks or snacks are also not allowed to be taken into the test hall.
- Applicants shall maintain perfect silence and attend to their questions only. All actions of the applicant in the test hall may be closely monitored using web cameras and closed circuit TV cameras. Any conversation or movement or disturbance in the test hall shall be deemed as misbehavior. If an applicant is found using unfair means or impersonating, his/her candidature will be cancelled and he/she will be liable to be debarred from taking examination either permanently or for a specified period to be decided by LPU. LPU also reserves the right to withhold the result of such applicant.
- Applicants must sign the attendance sheet in the presence of the invigilator. The invigilator will also put his/her signature in the place provided in the e-hall ticket of the candidate.
- For appearing in the test, applicants will have to make arrangements for traveling and boarding at their own.

8. APPLICATION FORM

Application form is provided in Part C of the Prospectus 2017.

10. INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING APPLICATION FORM

Item-1- Registration Number

Fill registration number in the Application form, in case the applicant has already taken provisional admission in the university.

Item-2- Details of Qualifying Examination

Tick the appropriate box to indicate whether you have passed or are appearing. Depending on the program applying for, give the details of qualifying examination (e.g. Diploma/ 10th/ 10+2/ Graduation). Fill Month and Year of Passing/Appearing in the exam. Write the percentage of marks scored in the qualifying exam, if already passed.

Item-3- Complete Contact Details of the Applicant

Write the complete contact details of the applicant in capital letters. The address must include your father's name, and all other details including the correct pin code, for letters to reach you. Indicate your phone no. with the correct STD code, Mobile Number & email ID. Please note that this block may be machine-scanned and therefore the details should be written within the rectangular box provided. This address will be used on the E-Hall Ticket/ Appointment Letter/ Admit Card.

Item-4-Date of Birth

Write the day, month and year of your birth as per the English calendar and as recorded in your School Board/+2/ Intermediate/ Pre-University examination certificate. Use numerals 01 to 31 for DATE, numerals 01 to 12 for MONTH, and the last four digits for the YEAR of birth. For example, if born on 7th January 1995, the date should be entered as follows: 07/01/1995.

Item-5-Gender

Tick the appropriate box depending upon your gender.

Item-6-Category

Tick the appropriate box specified in this item number, If it is not specified here, then write in the text area provided. (For statistical purpose only).

Item-7-Exam Date

There are two options to book the slot for taking test. If applicants want University to book the slot, tick option 1 (University). If they wish to book the slot themselves, tick option 2 (Student).

Item-8-Test City

Refer to the codes for Test Cities, where you want to appear for exam, in ANNEXURE - A and write the appropriate code in the space provided. Write the name of the city as well in the text area provided.

Item - 9- Choice of Exam Date

If applicant has ticked option 1 in ITEM-7, then five options of Choice of Exam Date are to be given here. Write Day, Month and Year as per English calendar. Dates mentioned here should be between 10th April 2017 to 10th August 2017. Considering postal delays/ holidays etc. the dates mentioned should be at least 7 days later than the current date i.e. date of posting the application.

Item - 10- Programme applying for

Indicate the programme you are applying for by ticking the corresponding box.

Item - 11 - Declaration

The applicant must sign the declaration and fill up the place and date. Applications without signatures will be treated as incomplete and rejected.

12. IMPORTANT DATES FOR LPUNEST - 2017
