As we have seen, fat is crucial to survival, and there can be little doubt about the evolutionary history of our preference for it in our diet. In addition to fat, are there other substances that are so important to our basic physiology that we must have them? Salt is one of those essential minerals that we require for normal physiological function. The sodium and chloride found in salt along with potassium, are electrolytes, substances that when in the proper solvent will conduct ions. Electrolytes are important in regulation of the body's fluid levels as well as the balance of acids and bases.

Considerable research has been conducted on salt by physiologists as well as ecologists. Physiologists are concerned with the regulation and management of electrolytes, while ecologists are interested in how we acquire our taste for salt. Is our preference for salt learned, and if so, how is it accomplished? Alternatively, is our predilection for salt a consequence of our evolutionary history? Of course, the answer is both, but there are some other interesting answers to the recurring "why" question. Ecologists have noted that one of the consequences of heavy rain fall is the depletion of sources of sodium present in the food of land-dwelling herbivores. This is particularly true for animals that are far from the ocean. Female manimals may have developed a predisposition for salt due to the demands of pregnancy and lactation. Manimals with a highly developed preference for salt would be favoured in an environment where sources of salt were unpredictable. When salt was encountered, consumption of substantial quantities could have provided a reserve on which an individual might draw.






