LFAT Syllabus for Reasoning, Mental Ability and Legal Aptitude

Part 3 of LFAT comprises questions from 3 sections, that are Reasoning, Mental Ability and Legal Aptitude. There are a total of 50 questions with each carrying 2 marks. The maximum mark an individual can score in this section is 100. Given below are the important topics from Reasoning, Mental Ability and Legal Aptitude:

Key Points of LFAT 2021 Syllabus

Some of the key points of LFAT 2021 syllabus are listed below:

- There are three parts of the LFAT syllabus where questions are from Language Comprehension, General Awareness & Current Affairs and Reasoning, Mental Ability & Legal Aptitude. Each part has a total of 50 questions for 100 marks.
- The questions in the Language Comprehension section of LFAT are designed to test the knowledge of the students in Hindi and English language, particularly in composition and grammar.
- The questions of General Awareness & Current Affairs are framed to evaluate the general awareness and knowledge of students about current and significant international and national affairs.



- The Reasoning, Mental Ability and Legal Aptitude section of LFAT is set at testing the legal aptitude, reasoning power and mental ability of candidates.
- LFAT follows a negative marking scheme where 1/3rd marks are deducted in Part 1 & 2 and 2/3rd marks are reduced in Part 3 for incorrect answers.
