1. The shortlisting criteria for admission of M.Tech. Program in Energy Studies (JES) for Academic session 2021-2022 is given in the Table below:

Employees of Public Sector Undertakings / Government Organizations / Research & Development Organizations / Private Industries / Academic Institutions (approved by CES Faculty Board).</p> <p>ii. Minimum one year work experience as on date of registration.</p> <p>iii. Organizations of the candidate seeking admission on Part-time basis shall be located within 50 km radius of IIT Delhi. For part-time candidates from outside NCR (or at a radial distance of more than 50 km from IIT Delhi), there is a minimum residency requirement of 6 months. DRC/ CRC/SRC may specify a higher residency requirement based on the courses recommended as well as the background.</p> <p>iv. Sponsored (full-time) candidates seeking admission to a MTech program on the basis of study leave, must submit a “Sponsorship Certificate” on a proper letterhead from the appropriate authority in the organization clearly stating the following: <input type="checkbox"/> for the period of his/her studies in the program, the candidate would be treated as on duty with usual salary and allowances; and <input type="checkbox"/> that he/she will be fully relieved and granted study leave for a minimum period of 2 years (or equivalent degree holders).</p> <p>v. Part-time candidates are required to submit a “No Objection Certificate” (NOC) on a proper letterhead from the appropriate authority in the organization clearly stating the following: <input type="checkbox"/> the candidate is permitted to pursue studies on a part-time basis; <input type="checkbox"/> he/she will be fully relieved from duty and permitted to reside at the Institute for the period of required residency that is essential for completing the course work (this is not a requirement for candidates who are working in NCR or organizations located within a distance of 50 km from the Institute); <input type="checkbox"/> that his/her official duties permit him/her to attend required classes as per the Time Table of IIT Delhi; <input type="checkbox"/> that his/her official duties permit him/her to devote sufficient time for research; <input type="checkbox"/> facilities for research in the candidate’s field of research are available at the candidate’s place of work, in case the proposed MTech research plan requires him/her to use these facilities when the candidate is physically present at this place of work. Template of this NOC is available on the IIT Delhi PG admissions website.</p> <p>vi. No Objection Certificate from Employer as per IIT Delhi proforma shall be produced at the time of interview. The candidate without the certificates will not be interviewed.</p>

- CRC approved the above-mentioned eligible disciplines for the JES program as per above table. Disciplines other than those listed above will not be considered for admission in JES program.
- For all candidates with B.Tech. from IITs with a CGPA of 8.0 or above, the requirement of qualification through GATE is waived off.
- The final selection for the program for full time students with GATE Score will be based purely on GATE score whereas others (**IIT B. Tech, Part-Time and Sponsored Full-Time**), will have to appear for an interview via video-conferencing on 07/06/2021 [Monday]. Exact time and relevant details will be emailed to the candidates shortlisted for interview.
