- 2. How would you increase the water use efficiency of crops? Briefly describe the methods of reducing the run-off losses of irrigation water and explain the significance of drip and sprinkler irrigation. Narrate the qualities of irrigation water. How the drainage of water logged soils can be done?
- 3. Explain, with examples, on various groups of herbicides used in chemical weed control. How the weeds are disseminated and give a relationship about the crop-weed association? What is meant by biological weed control and how does it differ from cultural weed management?
- 4. What do you mean by agroforestry and how does it help in agriculture? Define and list out the essential nutrients and narrate how the soil fertility

is evaluated for fertilizer usage. Draw a sketch on how the fixation of nitrogen, phosphorus and potassium occur in soils. How their efficiency can be improved?

 - (a) How the climatic factors regulate the crop growth? Explain with suitable examples.
 - (b) Define Biodiversity. What are its sources and how it can be managed?
 - (c) Narrate how the environmental pollution becomes hazardous to crops and animals.
 - (d) Importance of farm planning and budgeting.
- Discuss how the co-operative plays a role in determining the economy of agriculture. Narrate how the Intellectual Property Rights is related to agriculture and its importance.
