Read the passage and answers the questions from 11 to 15:

The IITs are now under the scanner of the Supreme Court following an SLP for allegedly continuing irregularities and bungling in JEE for admissions. The apex court has issued notice to the Ministry of HRD. The SLP was filed by a CS Prof at IIT Kharagpur challenging the dismissal of his PIL by the Delhi High Court in June 2010 on the ground that he had no locus standi to challenge the validity of JEE. They are yet to disclose the complete data of JEE 2010. The evaluation scheme was changed after the examination and there were serious flaws in admission counselling based on JEE 2010 results.

The SLP also called for a single entrance examination, replacing all existing exams as IIT JEE, AIEEE and State exams. It further says that the RTI data on JEE was ridden with many discrepancies as adhocism in cut off determination, unattended errors in question settings/evaluation, tampering/shredding of ORS in undue haste, selecting IIT administrators' wards in some IITs, closed admission counselling resulting in irregularities in admissions and seats lying vacant, zero accountability for attending to apparent errors, poor ethics in JEE administration etc.

Proposals for corrective reforms have also been suggested in the SLP. A committee of independent experts to formulate single examination system rather than close-door committee of four IIT Directors too has been suggested. It has proposed seven reforms for JAB including release of model answers along with solutions immediately after the examination is over, releasing of marks at the time of results besides publishing status of vacant seats and filled-in seats on day to day basis during the admission counselling.

JEE నిర్వహించే ప్రవేశ పరీక్షల్లో అక్రమాలకు పాల్పడుతున్నట్లుగా వచ్చిన SLP తో ఇప్పుడు IIT లు సుప్రీంకోర్టు యొక్క సూక్ష్మ పరిశీలనలోకి వచ్చాయి. దేశంలోని అత్యున్నత న్యాయస్థానం మానవ వనరుల మంత్రిత్వశాఖకు నోటీసు జారీ చేసింది. JEE యొక్క విశ్వసనీయతను సవాలు చేసేందుకు ఏ విధమైన ఆధారాలు లేవని, ఖరగ్ పూర్ CS ప్రోఫెసర్ దాఖలా చేసిన SLP ని జూన్ 2010లో ఢిల్లీ హైకోర్టు కొట్టివేసింది. వారు JEE 2010 యొక్క పూర్తి వివరాలు ఇంకా వెల్లడించలేదు. పరీక్ష నిర్వహించిన తరువాత మూల్యాంక విధానాన్ని మార్చడము మరియు JEE 2010 ఫలితాల ఆధారంగా ప్రవేశాల కోసం జరిపిన కౌన్సిలింగ్ లో చాలా తీవ్రమైన లోపాలు ఉన్నాయి అనే వివాదం ఉంది.

ప్రస్తుతం అమల్లో ఉన్న అన్ని ప్రవేశ పరీక్షలైనటువంటి IIT JEE, AIEEE మరియు రాష్ట్రంలో జరిగే అన్ని పరీక్ష ల విధానాలకు బదులు ఒకే పరీక్ష నిర్వహణ కోసం SLP కూడా పిలుపునిచ్చింది.

వీటన్నిటిని సరిదిద్దే సంస్కరణల యొక్క ప్రతిపాదనలు కూడా SLP లో సూచించబడినాయి. కేవలం నాలుగు IIT ల డైరెక్టర్స్ తో కూడిన రహస్య కమిటీ కంటే ఒక స్వతంత్రమైనటువంటి సంబంధిత సబ్జెక్ట్ లో నిపుణులుగా ఉండే విధంగా ఒక కమిటీ ఏర్పాటుకు కూడా సూచన ఇవ్వడమైనది. పరీక్ష పూర్తయిన వెంటనే ఫలితాలతో పాటు మోడల్ సమాధానాల విడుదలతో పాటు మరో ఏడు సంస్కరణలను కూడా SLP ప్రతిపాదించింది. ఫలితాలు వెల్లడించేటప్పుడు విడుదల చేసే మార్కులతో పాటు ఖాళీగా ఉన్న సీట్ల వివరాలు కూడా ప్రచురించే పద్ధతిని మరియు ప్రవేశ కౌన్సిలింగ్ లో రోజువారీగా భర్తీ అయిన సీట్లతోపాటు ఖాళీలను కూడా ప్రచురించే విధానాన్ని అనుసరించాలని నిర్ణయించింది.

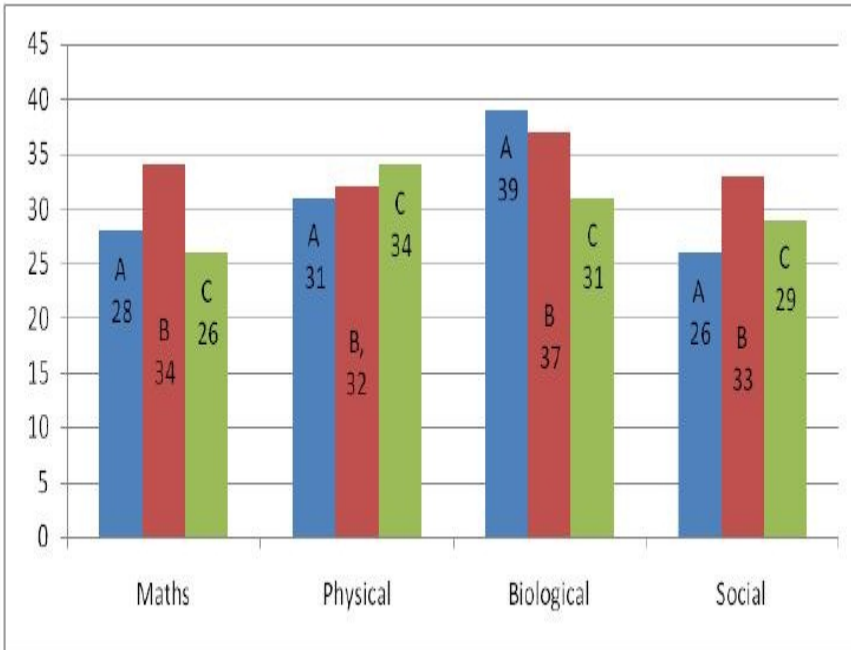
