SECTION - B (Reading Skills)

Q2. Read the given passage carefully and answer the questions:-

- 1). The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) is the space agency of the Government of Republic of India headquartered in the city of Bengluru. Its vision is to harness the space technology for national development, while pursuing space research and planetary exploration.
- 2). Formed in 1969, ISRO superseded the erstwhile Indian National committee for Space Research (INCOSPAR) established in 1962 by the efforts of Prime Minister Jawaharlal. These rockets have launched numerous communication and observation satellites. Satellite navigation system like GAGAN and IRNSS

has been deployed. In January 2014, ISRO successfully used an indigenous cryogenic engine in GSLV-D5 launch of GSAT-14.

3). ISRO built India's first satellite, Aryabhata, which was launched by Soviet Union on 19 April 1975. It was named after mathematician Aryabhata. In 1980 Rohini was to become the first satellite to be placed in orbit by an Indian-made launch vehicle, SLV-3. ISRO subsequently developed two other rockets: the Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV) for launching satellites into Polar orbits and Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle (GSLV) for placing satellites.

4). ISRO sent one lunar orbiter; Chandrayaan-1, on 22 October 2008 and one Mars orbiter, which successfully entered Mars orbit on 24 September 2014, making India the first nation to succeed in its first attempt. Future plans include human spaceflight, further lunar exploration, interplanetary probes, and a solar spacecraft mission. On 18 June 2016 ISRO set a record with a launch of 20 satellites in a single payload, one being a satellite from Google. On 15 February 2017 ISRO launched 104 satellites in a single rocket (PSLV-C37) and created a world record. Nehru and his close aide and scientist Vikram Sarabhai with the establishment of ISRO thus institutionalized space activities in India. It is managed by the Department of Space, which reports to the Prime Minister of The Republic of India.

i) Much before medical science discovered it, Reader's Digest came out with the prescription laughter is the best medicine. Newspapers and magazines which regularly run humour column, are therefore, doing their bit to keep the readers in good health. Reading light articles, whether they be satirical, comic or just humorous, relieves the tedium of work-a-day world. Some piece may even tickle one's grey matter.

(ii) It is said that if you laugh for ten minutes, you will be in a better position to put up with pain for two hours. According to US researchers, laughter is a good antidote to stress that tone up the system. Facial laugh, muscles instruct the brain to 'feel good' regardless of how you feel.

iii) According to a French doctor, laughter deepens breathing, improves blood circulation, speeds up the process of tissue healing and stabilizes many body functions. In short, it acts as a power drug with no side effects. Researchers state that laughter stimulates production of beta endorphins, natural painkillers in the body and improves digestion. You can hire a 'jovialist' who cracks jokes and laughs and promises to make you dissolve your worries in helpless laughter.
