

# **Joint Graduate Entrance Examination for Biology and Interdisciplinary Life Sciences (JGEEBILS)**

The exam consists of 4 sections, split into 2 sub-sections, General A and B, Physics A and B, Chemistry A and B, and Biology A and B.

The exam tests the ability to synthesise topics that you have learnt during a typical science course during high school or during your undergraduate. There are no other special topics required.

All questions are multiple choice and have **ONLY ONE** correct answer. Answer them by clicking the radio button next to the relevant option. They can appear in any order within the section.

All sections have a total of 15 questions, with 10 in sub-section A and 5 in sub-section B.

Correct answers in the A sub-section are worth 1 mark, and in the B sub-section, 2 marks. Note there will be negative marking for incorrect answers.
