ATMA Syllabus

ATMA syllabus is divided into three sections – Analytical Reasoning, Verbal Skills and Quantitative Skills. The exam paper will have total 180 objective type multiple choice questions. Candidates need to solve these questions within 3 hours.

We have provided the section-wise ATMA syllabus below -

Syllabus for Analytical Reasoning

Analytical Reasoning section assess a candidate's ability to think logically. This section is divided into two parts -1 and 2. Each part will have 30 questions each. The syllabus consists of topics like Critical Reasoning, Arguments, Statements & conclusions, Arrangements etc. The syllabus for Analytical Reasoning -
