FOOTBALL

Question 6

- (iii) What will be the referee's decision, when a player denies the opposing team a goal or an obvious goal-scoring opportunity by deliberately handling the ball in the penalty area. [1]
- (iv) A player indulges in misconduct even after receiving a yellow card. What will be the decision of the referee? [1]

CRICKET

Question 7

- (i) Mention *any four* conditions when the ball is considered as dead ball by the umpire. [4]
- (ii) Draw a well labelled diagram of a cricket pitch with all specifications and dimensions. [4]
- (iii) What will be the decision of the umpire, when the ball touches a fielder's helmet kept behind the wicket keeper during the game? [1]
- (iv) In a cricket match, a wicket falls, and the next batsman does not reach the crease in time. What will be the decision of the umpire? [1]

HOCKEY

Question 8

- (i) Explain *forehand pass*. [4]
- (ii) State *any four* responsibilities of an Umpire in a game of Hockey. [4]
- (iii) A player behaves unsportingly and argues with the umpire. What will be the decision of the umpire? [1]
- (iv) What will be the decision of the umpire if a player obstructs his/her opponent player from playing the ball? [1]

BASKETBALL

- (ii) Draw a neat diagram of a Basketball court, with all dimensions. [4]
- (iii) In a basketball match, two opponents commit personal fouls against each other, at the same time. What will be the decision of the referee? [1]
- (iv) What decision will be taken by the referee if during the game, a player does a double dribble? [1]

- (ii) Answer the following questions:

 - (b) What is meant by *screening*? [2]

- (iii) What will be the decision of the referee if a server serves the ball at the 6th second after the first referee whistles for service? [1]
- (iv) During a volleyball match, a player hits the ball, and it lands on the line. What will be the decision of the referee? [1]

TENNIS

Question 11

- (i) Explain *forehand shot*. [4]
- (ii) State *any four* instances when a player loses a point during the game. [4]
- (iii) What happens if the ball touches the net during the serve but lands in the correct service area? [1]
- (iv) What will be the decision of the umpire, if a ball touches a player's racket two times, consecutively? [1]

BADMINTON

Question 12

- (i) Mention *any four* faults a player might commit during the game. [4]
- (ii) Draw a neat diagram of a shuttle with all specifications. [4]
- (iii) According to the rules of the game, what happens when a shuttle hits the body of a player during a rally or a service? [1]
- (iv) What will be the decision of the umpire if, during the game, the server serves before the receiver is ready? [1]

SWIMMING

Question 13

- (i) List the equipment required for a swimming event. [4]
- (ii) Discuss the basic strokes in swimming. [4]
- (iii) In a swimming event, a swimmer tries to obstruct the path of another swimmer by swimming into his/her lane. What will be the decision of the judge? [1]
- (iv) What will be the decision of the judge if a swimmer does an incorrect stroke in a swimming competition? [1]

ATHLETICS

Question 14

- (i) What is *high jump*? Name the different techniques of high jump. [4]
- (ii) What is meant by stagger distance? For a 400 m track race, state the stagger distance for each lane of a standard track. [4]
- (iii) What will be the decision of the judge when an athlete steps out of the throwing circle while attempting a throw in a discus event group? [1]
- (iv) What will be the decision of the judge if an athlete false starts in a 100m track event? [1]
