PRACTICAL GUIDELINES FOR CLASS- XII

Assessment of performance:

A single examiner should be assigned for the conduct and assessment of Practical Examinations each in Senior Secondary School Curriculum. Question for the viva examinations should be conducted by the examiner. Question to be more of General nature, project work or the curriculum. Investigatory Project especially those that show considerable amount of effort and originality, on the part of the student, should get suitable high marks, while project of a routine or stereotyped nature should only receive mediocre marks.

Contents of Practical File/Student Portfolio:

JOB 1: INTRODUCTION OF OFFICE, STATIONERY CHART & STOCK REGISTER AND COMPUTER ACCESSORIES DIAGRAM.

- After the visit, a Project Report indicating different items of office stationery, stock register entry etc. to be prepared by each student.
- The students will prepare the computer Charts such as Computer accessories.

JOB II: OFFICE-SPACE, ENVIRONMENT, USE OF DIPHTHONGS, COMPUTER MS - DOS COMMANDS.

- The changing scenario in the office being visited has to be observed by the students and their views presented in the Project Report.
- The Student practice list of Diphthongs and use of triphones, phrases etc.
- The Students will prepare the computer Diagram such as MS-DOS commands.

JOB III: TELEPHONE DIRECTORY, COMPUTER CHART, CIRCLE S & Z, C.C.T.V.

- The students should practice Telephone Directory, Post office guide book, Railway time table.
- The student prepare the chart of computer with different type of MS Word menus.
- Practice of Circle S & Z as their direction etc.

- Make the diagram of C.C.T.V.

JOB IV: SECRETARY DUTIES, M.S. WORD MENU, LARGE CIRCLE AND LOOP.

- The students should practice Secretary Duties.
- The students should practice preparation of Resume and fill up online job application forms.
- Practice of large circle and loop words in shorthand.
- Write text matter and apply different M S Word commands.

NOTE:

1. The above mentioned activities are proposed for the preparation of Project File (Practical File/Student Portfolio). The Project File should contain activities from each unit.
2. The practical work should be as near as the actual work performed in an Office.
3. The marks to be allocated should be based on the quality of work done by the students as per the Curriculum.
4. The teacher conducting the final practical examination may ask verbal questions related to the project work done by the student.
