The Surface of the Earth called the crust moves all the time, but this movement is so slow that we are not aware of it. Eventually, however, pressure builds up and causes earthquakes and volcanoes. Changes also happen when the crust is worn away by water or huge blocks of moving ice called Glaciers.

Our planet can support life only because it gets light and heat from the Sun. without it, the Earth would be cold, dark and dead place.
