

# MAH MBA CET 2022 Exam Analysis

MAH MBA CET 2022 was conducted on August 23, 24, and 25, 2022 in different sessions. The MAH MBA CET exam analysis 2022 has been made available here. The difficulty level of the question papers on all three days was easy. Like the last year, the questions appeared in a jumbled manner and were not clubbed into separate sections which led to some confusion among the students. All the questions from Logical Reasoning, Abstract Reasoning, Quantitative Aptitude, and Verbal Ability had no specific order.

## Detailed MAH MBA CET 2022 Exam Analysis for Day 1

Overall, the exam conducted on August 23, 2022, was on the easier side. Critical reasoning was not there. Students found problems in LR question of Linear Arrangement sets. ## Detailed MAH MBA CET 2022 Exam Analysis for Day 2

As compared to Day 1, the MAH MBA CET exam on Day 2 was difficult. However, the overall difficulty level of the exam conducted on August 24 was moderate. Logical reasoning was slightly difficult with a total of 65-70 questions. Like Day 1, MAH MBA CET 24th Aug 2022 question paper was jumbled and had no specific order. There was also a technical glitch due to which students faced some issues. Some grammatical errors in the VARC section were also observed. ## Detailed MAH MBA CET 2022 Exam Analysis for Day 3

Both the shifts of MAH MBA CET 25th Aug 2022 exam were easy. However, there was a lot of difference on Day 3 question papers in terms of topic-wise weightage from Day 1 and 2. No questions from Data Interpretation, Data Sufficiency, Syllogism or Grammar were asked on Day 3. But like the rest of the question papers from previous shifts, day 3 papers also had most questions from the Logical Reasoning section.
